

Adventures in Driving, LLC Training Agreement

Adventures in Driving, hereinafter referred to as "The Driving School" shall furnish a licensed instructor and a dual-controlled, fully insured vehicle for teaching the student. The Student is required to complete all available training within 6 months of the date the training begins. Upon expiration of this agreement, a reinstatement fee may be charged before any further services are provided. The school does not guarantee that a driver's license will be secured for your son or daughter; or that they will be safe and a responsible driver. If training is not completed within the six months, a new agreement shall be established and training shall be restarted.

Complete Driving Course

The Driving School agrees to furnish a licensed instructor and a motor vehicle for a total of 8 clock hours behind the wheel instruction (based on the "Ohio Driving Training Curriculum") for a charge of \$ **750.00**. All 24 hours of classroom work must be complete prior to beginning the behind-the-wheel training. No Refund: Except moving out of state.

Account must be paid in full before or on the first drive. A Certificate of Completion will not be released until the account is paid in full. The Driving School shall furnish a certificate of completion to all students who successfully complete the course. Completion, as defined by the State of Ohio, refers to the completion of the required number of hours, the student's good faith effort having been exercised during the practical driving portion, and the attainment of a score equal to or greater than 75% on the performance measurement. You cannot schedule a driving exam/test with the state until you receive your certificate of completion.

Additional in-car training may be obtained at an hourly rate of \$ 75.00. Student, upon the approval of the Driving School, may, for an additional fee of \$ **100.00** use the Driving School's vehicle (and have a short prep session) to take a driving exam at a State exam center located in Greene County, OH. Should a check received as payment of tuition in whole or in part, be returned due to insufficient funds, the Student may be removed from the driving schedule until such check is made good. An additional fee may be charged for any returned check.

Contract expires in 6 months: .

This contract expires in 6 months, the date of which starts on the date of the first drive.

Transportation to and from the facility will not be paid for by the school.
